PERMIT TO CONSUME

Standards for issuance of permit to consume 3.2% beer in public areas.

- A. A permit shall be issued only to:
 - 1. An individual; or
 - 2. An office or agent authorized to apply for such a permit on behalf of a legal entity organized under or recognized by the laws of the State of Colorado.
- B. The person applying for such permit for him or herself or on behalf of such entity must be at least twenty-one years of age.
- C. A permit may be issued for social, fraternal, patriotic, athletic, religious, or charitable events.
- D. Denial of permit
 - 1. Issuance of such permit may be denied upon the grounds that such issuance would be detrimental to the public safety, health, morals, order, or welfare by reason of the nature of the event, the likelihood, in the reasonable judgment of the office of the City responsible for review and issuance of the permit, that the event would create a public nuisance or result in the consumption of alcoholic beverages by minors, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant or permit holder in a past event, for which a permit was required, to conduct such event in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
 - 2. Issuance of such permit may be denied if another event has previously been scheduled for that location on the same day for which the permit is sought or if issuance of the permit would unreasonably interfere with normal activities and customary and general use and enjoyment of the location.
 - 3. Preference shall be given to residents of the City of Commerce City and to commercial and industrial enterprises located within the corporate limits of the City of Commerce City for use of public areas under the control of the City.
- E. The City Manager or Director of Parks and Recreation may require any applicant to post a performance bond or letter of credit acceptable to the City attorney to assure compliance with the ordinance. Any costs to the City of cleaning or policing may be withheld from the performance bond.
- F. Each permit shall be issued for a specific location and is not valid for any other location.
- G. **No alcohol shall be permitted at any time at Freedom Park.**
- H. Permits shall be valid only for the period issued.
- I. Permits are valid for the individual or entity to which they are issued and are not transferrable.
- J. Both the applicant and the permit holder shall be personally responsible for any cleaning, trash disposal, or repairs necessary as a result of the event for which the permit is granted.
- K. The permit must be in the possession of the permit holder or applicant at and during the event and must be produced upon request of a peace officer.
- L. The permit holder will control the consumption of alcohol in compliance with City and State regulations.
- M. All ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City remain in full force and effect (Ord. 1433)
- N. Effective April 1, 2011, in accordance with the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code, Section 7-1014, smoking is prohibited in city parks, trails, open spaces and recreation facilities, with the exception of any areas of park property that are designed and intended for the parking of automobiles.

Code of Ordinances of the City of Commerce City

Sec. 12-5006 Open Containers.

It shall be unlawful for any person to possess any open container that hold an alcoholic beverage while on any street, sidewalk, alley, or in an automobile, city park or recreation area or any other public place, except in those public places which are duly licensed for the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages. Notwithstanding the foregoing, it shall not be a violation of this section for a person to possess an open container that holds a fermented malt beverage (3.2% beer) in a city park when the person is doing so pursuant to a permit issued by the city.
