

# East 104th Avenue IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 3B

## East 104th Avenue Improvements Project Phase 3B

### Project Overview

The E. 104th Avenue Improvements Project includes widening the existing two-lane road to four lanes. Traffic signals and raised medians will be installed and acceleration, deceleration and turning lanes will be added. An additional two-lane overpass also will be installed over I-76.

### Construction Progress

Newly completed work includes the installation of additional street lighting, newly constructed roadway and new drainage pipe installations at the intersection of 104th Avenue and Havana Street. These improvements will increase safety for motorists and extend the design life of the road. The I-76 bridge is 100% complete, sidewalks on the south side are 95% complete, storm drainage/sewer/waterline are 90% complete. The south portion of the O'Brien Bridge is 90% complete.

### Upcoming Schedule and Impacts:

Construction is on schedule and the second full-closure of Havana Street is underway. This closure is anticipated to last through September 2015. Work will include the installation of a water-quality pond at the northwest corner of I-76 and Havana Street, which will improve stormwater drainage. Florence Street will be open during this closure for access to area businesses, but commuters are encouraged to use US 85, or State Highway 2, as alternate routes.

Regular construction hours are Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Occasional night work and weekend work may occur to help facilitate traffic. Please obey posted speed limits within the construction zone. The project team cares about the safety of both the crew as well as motorists, and asks that travelers take extra caution in the construction zone. The team is grateful to area businesses and residents for their understanding and patience during construction.
