

Second Creek Recreation Center



The new recreation center at Second Creek is one of five projects in Commerce City's voter-approved capital improvement plan. The site is located at the northeast corner of E. 112th Avenue and Potomac Street in northern Commerce City.

The project includes an approximately 106,000-square-foot building, site infrastructure, and road and utility work. The new recreation center elements and programs will be coordinated with the existing recreation center to ensure compatibility and comprehensive programming for the entire community.

- Indoor pool
- Pool party rooms
- Gymnasium with elevated walking/jogging track
- Group fitness rooms
- Self-directed fitness areas
- Gymnastics center
- Family locker rooms
- Child care
- Catering kitchen
- Community wing with event space for 300 people
- Technological commons area
- Approximately 350 parking spaces
- Site infrastructure, road and utility work

Process

Commerce City held public meetings, focus group meetings and online/paper surveys in August 2015 to obtain feedback about programming elements for the new recreation center and the existing recreation



center. Over 800 community members participated. City council made design decisions based on community and citizen advisory committee input. The project team refined the design to reflect the community's input while staying within schedule and budget. Final design was presented to city council in summer 2016.


