

E. 68th Avenue Safety Improvements

From Colorado Boulevard to Brighton Boulevard



About the Project

Commerce City is improving E. 68th Avenue to enhance safety and create a more pedestrian-friendly corridor for people walking, biking, driving, and taking transit. The 0.40-mile project extends between Colorado Boulevard and Brighton Boulevard (SH 265), serving nearby neighborhoods, Alsup Elementary School, Rose Hill Grange Park, and local residents.

Project Goals



Make walking and biking safer traveling to and from Alsup Elementary School and nearby parks



Improve connections for people walking or biking to the RTD Light Rail Station




Fix drainage and accessibility issues

The project improvements for increased safety may include:

- Wider sidewalks, new and improved crosswalks, curb extensions at intersections (bulb outs), ADA-compliant curb ramps, lane striping updates, better street lighting, and drainage improvements.
- Some crosswalks may also include Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs), which are flashing lights that alert drivers when someone is crossing.
