The Older Adult/Senior Center has a new name - and will soon have a new sign!

The Older Adult/Senior Center has a new name – the Active Adult **Center at Eagle Pointe!**

After 30 years of serving Commerce City residents, the Older Adult/ Senior Center located at the Eagle Pointe Recreation Center has a NEW name—the Active Adult Center at Eagle ranks of other municipalities across Pointe!

After meeting with Senior Advisory Committee members and focus group participants earlier this year, the decision to change the name was made to better serve the needs and interests of the growing "baby boomer" population (adults born between 1946-1964). The boomer generation is expected to double by the year 2030. The Active Adult Center will be a community and enrichment center for adults at all stages in life, including the boomer generation.

There is also a trend in transitioning from traditional senior centers to innovative active adult centers. According to the National Council on Aging, an organization that partners with communities to provide programs, services and advocacy, there are almost 10,000 active adult centers across the country. The Active Adult Center at Eagle Pointe will be joining the the metro region that have already made this change, from Aurora to Wheatridge.

New active adult programming for summer 2018 includes special enrichment programs, from culinary classes to computer classes in the new technology labs. (The technology lab at Eagle Pointe is expected to be completed by the end of 2018). Programming will take place at both Eagle Pointe and the new Bison Ridge Recreation Center to ensure compatibility for the entire community. Look for more detailed programming information in the new parks, recreation and golf guide coming to mailboxes in early April.


