City working with BNSF on train horn issues at 96th/Hwy 2

In recent weeks, the city has heard multiple complaints from Eagle Creek residents about passing trains failing to observe the quiet zone and blowing their horns through the crossing at E. 96th Avenue and Highway 2 near the neighborhood. We understand this is a major annoyance for residents and apologize for the excess noise pollution. The city is working with BNSF Railway to find a resolution to the issue as quickly as possible.

The city and our signal contractor have conducted multiple tests to confirm that the city's wayside horn equipment is functioning properly. The cause of the problem, and the reason some trains are blowing their horns while others are not, appears to be procedural. Sometimes engineers are required to blow their horns if they perceive a safety issue. For example, when a train is in the crossing on one set of tracks or the crossing is blocked for a lengthy period, trains passing on the other track blow their horns to warn drivers.

The city is working with BNSF to determine why this has become more of an issue recently and what can be done to reduce instances of trains blowing their horns through the quiet zone. We hope to have more information soon and will continue working toward a solution that allows the wayside horn to do its job.

Executive Summary:

This weekly update is intended to provide an overview of recent applications that have been submitted to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) or City applications within Commerce City boundaries.

City Oil and Gas Permits

The city has deemed the following Oil and Gas Permit submittals complete:

Condor Well Site:

On October 17th, the permit application for the Condor well site was deemed complete by the city. Upon further review of the permit, it was discovered that the application was not notarized and signed by the landowner. Per section 21-3150 of the Land Development Code, an application must either be submitted by the property owner or a duly authorized agent. The previous application status given was done so in error, and the application submittal has been deemed **not complete**. A discrepancy has been noted in the location of the Oil and Gas Permit submittal, versus the location generally contemplated under the land owner's current PUD (Planned Unit Development) Zone Document application (Z-953-20). Once the necessary application materials needed to demonstrate owner's consent of the application is received, the application status will be appropriately reflected, and the application will continue being processed.

The table below shows the date each permit was submitted to the city, the date the permit application was deemed complete per section 5.2 of the Regional Operator Agreement, and the review status for each permit. Upon being referred out to a number of internal and external review entities, the permit undergoes an initial six-week review cycle, and is then scheduled for an internal Development Review Team (DRT) meeting. A comment letter is then issued to the applicant, informing them of revisions that need to be made to the permit in order to continue the review process. For permits in the table above that require council action prior to approval, no final action will be taken on an administrative Oil and Gas Permit until council either approves, approves with conditions, or denies the relevant case. This table will be continuously updated as permits are under review by the city.
